Bashas' cards may be reloaded - and we receive credit for these reloads. Fry's Loyalty card needs to be registered and Temple Beth Emeth has to be chosen in the Community Rewards section. It is easy to tell - at the very bottom of each Fry's receipt you will see "At your request, Fry's will donate to Temple Beth Emeth".

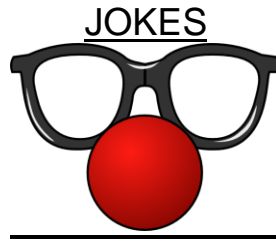
