Parkinson's Disease Clinical Study Opportunity

Imaging Endpoints is currently conducting a Phase 2 study to assess the efficacy, safety and pharmacodynamics of GZ/SAR402671 in patients with early-stage Parkinson's Disease carrying a GBA genetic mutation. The reason why this may be of interest to you is because this genetic mutation is more commonly found within the Ashkenazi Jewish community. This mutation is in no way specifically or heavily affects the Ashkenazi Jewish community, but recent research has shown that up to 9 percent carry the GBA mutation. To be eligible, patients will need to meet the following:

- Diagnosed with PD and are known heterozygous carriers of a GBA mutation OR carrying a known sequence variant associated with GBA- PD.
- 18-80 years of age
- Has symptoms of Parkinson's Disease for 2 years or greater
- If on Levodopa or any other PD medication, the medication regimen must be stable for at least 30 days.

The study is up to 3 years with 14 office visits and patients are compensated \$40 per visit for their time and travel. For referrals or to learn more, please contact Brian at 480-566-9090 or email at

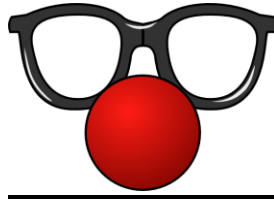
